A dual credit course is a course that provides a student with both high school and college credit. As of Fall 2022, Early College Courses, including dual credit courses, are charged at \$50 per credit hour. Tuition for some courses may be covered by funding from the West Virginia Level-Up Grant.

Juniors (11th Grade) ONLY

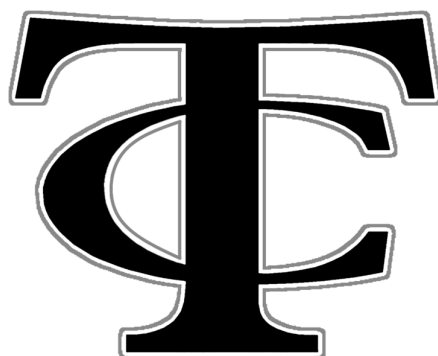
Juniors taking **US History** have the option to register and earn dual credit for the indicated WVU Parkersburg courses below.
